






Lego as Investment

Lego® sets can deliver returns that surpass well-established investment options. During the global financial crisis in February 2009, the S&P 500 Index hit its lowest point at approximately 735 points. If you had invested your money at that time, you would have experienced an average annual return of 38.5% up to the present day (December 2023).

On the other hand, in April 2007, the first Lego® Creator Expert Modular Building, known as the 10182 Café Corner, was introduced with a suggested retail price of €149.99. If you had invested in this set back in 2007, you would have enjoyed an annual return of 20.6% until now. Presently, the Lego set is being sold for as much as €3,020. This example is not an isolated incident, as there are other similar cases.

High return potential

Lego sets typically yield an average annual return of approximately 11%, and this rate can potentially increase further if the set is bought at a reduced price directly from the manufacturer.



Growing collector base

LEGO® sales in 2023 reached 17.1 billion DKK (CAGR of 12% from 2019 to 2023).



Short term strategy

Acquiring popular sets that are nearing the end of their lifespan at a reduced price provides an opportunity for a brief-term investment.

Counterfeit set

With premium Lego sets being highly sought-after and exclusive, counterfeit versions are frequently found in the market. As the demand for these sets grows, this problem will become increasingly significant. It's crucial to purchase only from reputable sellers.

Damaged sets

Properly handling and storing Lego sets is essential for preserving their intrinsic value. Whether buying a set from the original retailer or from resellers, it's important to inspect the condition of the packaging beforehand.

The reissue of existing Lego sets

The cost of a set might decrease if Lego opts to reintroduce the product as an updated version. It's important to note that such a reissue is quite uncommon.

Investment Case

Similar to physical possessions, there are fees and taxes associated with assets. The greater the value of the asset, the higher these expenses become. Therefore, when acquiring assets, the anticipated income should surpass these expenses for the investment to be worthwhile.
